February 5, 1959 - March 8, 2021

Lisa Ann Shields, age 62, of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Monday, March 8, 2021 at Billings Clinic. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Friday, March 19, 2021 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive, MT with Father Joseph Ponessa officiating. Rite of Committal will follow in Prairie County Cemetery in Terry, Montana. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Lisa was born on February 5, 1959 in Miles City, Montana, a daughter of Don and Rae (Buckingham) Hauk. They lived on the family farm outside of Terry until Lisa was ten years old at which time they moved to Stanford, Montana. During her high school years, she enjoyed band, choir, playing basketball, and running track. Lisa had a competitive drive and spirit that was contagious. She graduated as Salutatorian from Stanford High School with the class of 1977 and then furthered her education at Montana State University in Bozeman, Montana. While at MSU, Lisa's true love of learning earned her a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education, a Master's Degree in Education, and later a Doctorate Degree in Higher Education Administration. Her siblings were always proud to call her Doctor Shields! While studying at MSU she was active in the marching band, jazz band, and was a member of the Delta Gamma Sorority.

It was while working with her dad painting houses during her senior summer of high school that Lisa was inspired to follow in his footsteps and pursue a career as a music teacher. His belief that no student was unreachable, and his

ability to personally connect with his students, profoundly influenced Lisa throughout her life. Music and teaching were her passion and she touched many students throughout her career.

After beginning her teaching career in Dutton, Montana, Lisa married Jim Shields on August 13, 1983 in Stanford, and together they had one daughter, A'Lynn in 1984. Following their marriage, they moved to Glendive where she began teaching music at Dawson Community College in 1991 until she retired after 25 years at the college. Lisa was uniquely creative and always inspired her students to dream big and that any goal was reachable. The annual Madrigal Dinner at the college was an event many students and community members were involved with over the years. Among the many musicals her students performed was the Broadway musical, *Forever Plaid*, *Pirates of Penzance*, *Seven Brides for Seven Brothers*, along with many others, all played to a full house for every performance. By her side at all these wonderful events were her husband Jim, the man behind the scenes, her daughter A'Lynn, and all her family and close friends. To expose her students to all forms of music and experiences, she routinely toured with them to perform at high schools and venues throughout the state and attended operas and symphonies in Billings, Bozeman, and Missoula. Her family fondly remembers bringing a group of students from DCC to Billings to perform at her sister-in-law's baby shower!

Lisa was intensely loyal and was a true confidant and mentor to her students. She was often the first person they turned to for advice, encouragement, or simply when then needed a friendly ear to listen to, or shoulder to cry on. The sign leading into Lisa's office read "enter as friends and leave as family." Countless DCC students became life-long family to Lisa over the years! Following her retirement from DCC and a few years at home enjoying her family, her flower garden, and more time with her animals, Lisa's love of helping students led her back to the classroom where she taught band at Dawson County High School and Washington Middle School. Lisa spent countless extra hours at the school so students could get extra practice time

to improve their skills. Teaching was always a passion for her and she encouraged and inspired her students to always reach their full potential.

One of the most cherished times in her life came when she became a Grandma and was able to spend time taking care of her grandson Landry James. He was literally the light of her eye! Grandma “Ya Ya” and Landry were the greatest of buddies who spent numerous hours on colors, shapes, and words; she wanted to make sure he was ready for preschool. Lisa passed on her love of animals to him and loved every moment they shared together. On top of her love of music and her incredible talent playing the saxophone, Lisa also loved animals. The amount of care that she put into a hurt or sick animal was uncanny and her brothers would often joke about Lisa bringing animals back to life by feeding them with a medicine dropper by her bed. Lisa was very strong in her Catholic faith and enjoyed helping with anything the church needed. She was active in the Altar Society, Catholic Daughters, CCD, and with the adult and youth music ministries.

Lisa was preceded in death by her mother, Rae Hauk. She is survived by her husband Jim of Glendive, Montana, daughter A'Lynn Shields (Ryan Kalvoda) and her grandson Landry of Glendive, Montana, father Don Hauk of Stanford, Montana, sister Rochelle Whittaker (Chris) of Laveen, Arizona, brother Jeremy Hauk (Monica) of Billings, Montana, brother Matthew Hauk (Carla) of Great Falls, Montana, and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

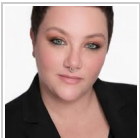

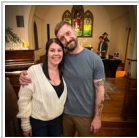
