Lloyd Malmend, age 81, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, December 15, 2008 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Visitation will be from 10:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Thursday, December 18, 2008 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Lloyd began painting with his dad in 1948 and continued painting all his life until his semi-retirement in 1993. Lloyd loved to fish, hunt agates, play cards and work on his home at 112 West Brennan Street. He was a member of the Glendive American Legion Post #28, serving as a commander for 3 years, a member of the Elks Lodge # 1324 and a member of Zion Lutheran Church. He is preceded in death by his parents, one daughter, Margie and one brother, Thomas.
