Lois had seven years of violin lessons as a young girl and continued her love of music when she took lessons to play the organ as an adult. Her organ resides at the Glendive Extended Care for many to enjoy. Lois grew up in and was a

lifelong member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and the bridge club for many years. Lois loved playing Kings in the Corner with her grandchildren, Alex and Carson. She belonged to a coffee club and a birthday club. She also had a great love of literature and was always in competition with that crossword puzzle. Lois spent the last six and a half years at the Heritage in Glendive and created wonderful memories with her Heritage family. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, one sister, Dorothy Adams, a brother, Buck and sister-in-law, Dorothy Lardy.
