Lola Keel, age 82, of Glendive, passed away on Saturday, March 18, 2006 at the Glendive Medical Center. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, March 23, 2006 at the First Baptist Church in Glendive with Pastor Ray Willis officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Lola was born on August 28, 1923 in Marietta, Oklahoma, the daughter of John James and Belle Mae (Willis) McAnally. She was raised and educated in Marietta, graduating from high school there in 1941. She married Dock Franklin Keel on November 8, 1942 in Marietta and continued to reside with her parents while her husband was overseas during WWII. In 1945 they moved to Spirit Lake, Idaho. Beginning in 1947 she accompanied her husband through the oilfields of West Texas eventually settling in Eunice, New Mexico in 1950. Between 1943 and 1966 she raised two sons while holding numerous full time bookkeeping positions. After somehow getting her two boys through high school and married off, in 1966 she again accompanied her husband to oil towns in Texas, Kansas, and Michigan. As a lifelong member of the Baptist Church she moved her membership in 1976 to the First Baptist Church of Coahoma, Texas. After she retired in Aug 1986, she filled her leisure time with family, Church activities, and traveling with friends. Eventually she moved to Glendive in 2003. Survivors include her sons, Gary(Tamami) Keel of Roseburg, Oregon and Bill (Bonita) Keel of Glendive; her sisters, Imogene Greenwood of Marietta and Rebecca (Howard) Smith of Big Spring,

Texas; nine grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren, one great great granddaughter and numerous nieces and nephews.
