



## Loraine Haase

August 15, 1919 - May 21, 2005

Loraine Georgie Alegria (Hollom) Haase, age 85, of Glendive, passed away on Tuesday, May 17, 2005 in the Glendive Medical Center. A Prayer Service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Friday, May 20, 2005 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 A.M., Saturday, May 21, 2005 at the United Methodist Church in Glendive with Pastor T.C. Chatman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Loraine was born on August 15, 1919 in Elmdale, Montana, the daughter of Andrew C. and Alvilda Otelja (Hellicksen) Hollom. She attended Goodwin Elementary School, Brockton High School for two years, Richey High School for one year and graduated from Brockton High School with the class of 1937. Loraine played six girl basketball during high school. Loraine worked as a stenographer in Sidney until moving to Seattle, Washington during World War II where she was employed by Boeing and later Alpine Dairy. She later returned to Sidney where she worked as a secretary for Babe Turner Agency. Loraine was known as "Tootsie" when she met Fred Haase and they were united in marriage on January 15, 1947 at the Methodist Church in Sidney. They lived north of Sidney and Loraine taught summer school at Goodwin School until she and her husband moved to Billings, Montana. They then moved to Glendive in 1952 where they built their own home and have resided here since. Loraine was a leader of the High Hopes 4-H Club for 20 years. She was a Sunday School teacher, was active in the

United Methodist Church and Community Bible Study Group. Loraine loved to sew for her family and friends, enjoyed cooking, baking and decorating wedding cakes and she made great mints. Loraine always like to sign "homemaker" on her tax return. Loraine was preceded in death by her parents and her siblings, Myrtle Edeburn, Evelyn Hollom, Oral A. Hollom, Darwin Hollom and Derema Hollom.
