Loren Harlan Deseth, age 67 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Wednesday, April 8, 2026 at his home in Glendive. A Celebration of Life will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, April 25, 2026 at the Silha Tribute Center in Glendive. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Loren was born on July 27, 1958 in Edmore, North Dakota to his parents Harlan and Barbara (Dufak) Deseth. He was raised and educated in Devils Lake, North Dakota before moving his junior year and finishing high school in Starkweather, North Dakota where he graduated with the class of 1978. After high school, Loren moved to California to live with his father and attend Diesel Mechanic's school in Oakland, California where he earned his associates degree. Following his education he enlisted in the United States Marine Corp in San Diego, California in 1980. He was stationed at Camp Lejune for one year before he served the next three years in Hawaii. After his honorable discharge from the military, Loren returned to North Dakota where he worked for a while before moving to Glendive in the early nineties. Loren worked for Cenex as a custom applicator for a short time before starting his career with the Montana Highway Department where he operated heavy equipment until his retirement in 2013. He continued to work part-time operating a lawn care business and mowing for the state.

Loren loved traveling and was passionate about hunting, gun collecting and auction sales. He was willing to help anyone who needed a hand, especially his family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents, his father, Harlan Deseth; one sister, LaVonne Schlieve and one nephew, Dana Schlieve.

He is survived by his mother and step-father, Barbara (Nick) Reiners; two brothers, Lonnie Deseth of Devils Lake and Larry Deseth of Milton, North Dakota; four sisters, LeeAnn (Tom) Charon of Langdon, North Dakota, LaRae Klier of Grand Forks, North Dakota, Lori Daniels and Lonna Gee both of Devils Lake and numerous nieces and nephews.

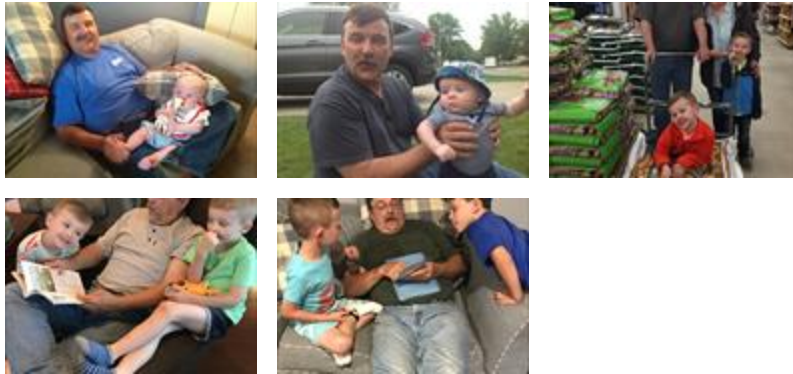
