Glendive, Montana: Lucille Anne Brown, age 80, passed away Sunday, March 6, 2011 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Unit. Lucille was a very dedicated member of the United Methodist Church and had served as President of the United Methodist Women. She was also very active in the International Order of Rainbow as well as Eastern Star where she had served as Worthy Matron. She dedicated her services of preparing meals for the Methodist Men's monthly meetings for over 25 years as well as having provided her assistance with providing lunches for various other church functions. Lucille received the "Diana Award" in 1984 from the Beta Nu Sorority for her volunteer work. She loved cooking, baking, enjoyed the

"Family Circus" cartoon strip in the newspapers and served as the family historian by keeping the family photographs and never forgetting a birthday or special occasion. Lucille enjoyed working as a babysitter, providing child care for anyone in need, even on short notice. Lucille is preceded in death by her parents; her husband Clinton in 1968; sons, Richard in 1979 and Michael in 1995; grandparents; infant sister, Elinor; and brothers, Carl, Robert and John.
