Lucille McEntire, age 90 of Billings, Montana passed away on Friday, July 16, 2021 in Billings. A Graveside service will be held at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, July 20, 2021 in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive, Montana with Pastor Dan Pust officiating. A full obituary will follow.
