



## LuVerna Prescott

January 11, 1929 - June 3, 2015

LuVerna V. Prescott, age 86, of Glendive, Montana, passed away Wednesday, June 3, 2015 at 6:05 P.M. at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive with her family by her side. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. until 2:00 P.M. on Saturday, June 6, 2015 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive. LuVerna was born on January 11, 1929 in Danzig, North Dakota, the daughter of John and Metta Hellerud. She had lived in Burnstad and Leal, North Dakota, Brooten, Minnesota and Outlook, Montana, graduating from Outlook High School with the class of 1945. She attended Concordia College from 1945 until 1948 and taught business classes in Outlook from 1948 to 1949. She married Robert Prescott on May 29, 1949 and returned to Concordia to graduate in 1950. She moved to Barnsville, Minnesota with Robert and lived there until 1960. In 1960, the family moved to Glendive, and in the following years, she started and taught seven years of kindergarten at Zion Lutheran, followed by sixteen years of Special Education at Dawson County High School.

LuVerna was a member of the Glendive Education Association, Glendive Community Concert Association, Cottonwood Country Club, PEO and DCAU.

LuVerna was deeply involved and committed to Zion Lutheran Church, where she sang in the church and community choirs for many years, taught Sunday School, and was a member of the Elizabeth Circle and Chancel Guild. Lu's true passions in life were her family, church, and music; and she was arguably the best lefse maker anywhere.

LuVerna was preceded in death by her parents and husband Robert. Survivors include daughters Sheryl Drewry of Post Falls, Idaho; son Gary Prescott of Polson, Montana; daughter and husband Deborah and Buster Elliott-Newton of San Diego, California; grandchildren Robert and David Drewry; Allison, Aubrey and Tucker Prescott; Connor Newton; Amanda, Randy and Beth James; eleven great-grandchildren; sisters, Agnes Selvig of Outlook, Montana, Janice Hiller and Connie Frank of Vancouver, Washington; brother, Jack Hellerud of Hollywood, California; close friend and companion Bus Morris and numerous nieces and nephews.
