Lynton Edward Nentwig, age 78 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Sunday, December 25, 2022 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. Family will receive friends from 10:00 AM until 1:00 PM on Thursday, December 29, 2022 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive, there will also be bars and refreshments at the Silha Tribute Center during this time. A private graveside service will be in the Pleasant View Cemetery in Dawson County. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Lynton was born on February, 22, 1944 to his parents Merton and Ardyce (Edwards) Nentwig in Glendive. He was raised and educated in Glendive, attending the Sunrise School through the eighth grade and then Dawson County High School where he graduated with the class of 1961. Following his education, Lynton enlisted in the United States Army where he was stationed in Germany for a while before returning to the States and receiving his honorable discharge. After his service, Lynton returned to Glendive where he farmed and ranched his entire life. In more recent years, he took on more of a supervisor role always making sure to bark orders.

Lynton married Darlene Schwartzbeck on May 7, 1981 and to this union three children were born.

Lynton enjoyed playing cards and coming to town for coffee with the guys. He was a lifetime member of the Moose Lodge and was very proud of being a part of the 1960 State Championship Football Team.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his brother Don Nentwig and his

wife Darlene Nentwig.
