Glendive, Montana: Mae Violet (Nemec) Sharbono, age 89, passed away on Sunday, December 30, 2012 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in Glendive. Mae was born on February 5, 1923 on the family farm near Savage, Montana a daughter of Frank and Mary (Mucha) (of Czechoslovakia) Nemec. She received her early education in Savage schools graduating as Valedictorian from Savage High School. Following graduation, Mae attended Billings Normal College in Billings, Montana where she earned her teaching certificate. As a Teacher, Mae taught all eight grades for several years in a rural one room school. Mae met and later married Donald Sharbono in Sidney, Montana on July 13, 1941. In 1943, a son Leslie was born. When Don was drafted into the United States Army in 1943, Mae and Leslie went to live in California to be near him. After Don's honorable discharge from military service they moved to Glendive where their daughter, Sandra was born. Mae and Don bought a farm south of Savage where they raised their two children. Early in the 1970's, Mae asked the Lord to be her savior and she lived her life accordingly from that time on. In 2003, Mae and Don moved to

Billings, Montana where Don passed away in 2004. Following Don's passing Mae returned to Glendive in 2007 where she resided until the time of her death. Mae was a tremendous cook who loved to cook for everyone. She enjoyed sewing, gardening and playing board games. During the Christmas season, Mae would play the violin while everyone would sing Christmas Carols. Mae loved to sing to her children and grandchildren while rocking them and of course teaching them. Mae was preceded in death by her parents, Frank and Mary Nemeč; husband, Donald Sharbono; in 2004; son, Leslie in 1993; sisters, Annie and Marie; and brothers, Joseph and Frank.
