



## Magdalena "Maggie" Malarchick

August 25, 1912 - February 18, 2010

GLENDIVE, MONTANA: Magdalena "Maggie" Malarchick, age 97, of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Sunday, February 14, 2010, at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 1:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M., Wednesday, February 17, 2010, in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Maggie loved fishing and tying flies. She especially enjoyed cooking, whether it was working with dough, making cookies, or cooking German dishes. She liked playing all kinds of card games. On August 19, 1993, Maggie married Wayne Malarchick. Maggie and Wayne continued to reside in Glendive, and in 2002, Maggie moved into the Eastern Montana Veterans Home. Maggie was preceded in death by her

parents and eight sisters and brothers.
