



Mahlon Borntrager

February 25, 1918 - October 20, 2013

Mahlon Glenn Borntrager passed away October 20, 2013 at the age of 95. He had resided at Grandview Retirement home in Glendive, Montana since 1997, although his last weeks were at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care after pneumonia. He was a joy to those around him, and he left this world with joy at going to his eternal home. There will be a memorial service 10:00 A.M. on June 27, 2014 at the Red Top Mennonite Church in Bloomfield, Montana. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Mahlon was born in Bloomfield on February 25, 1918 to Glenn Joseph and Cora (Chupp) Borntrager. He was raised on the family farm and went to grade school at Red Top School, near Bloomfield, and also attended Dawson High School through his sophomore year. He served in CPS (Civilian Public Service) Camps in California and Oregon from 1942 until 1946, and participated in projects with the Mennonite Disaster Service as well. He spent the remainder of his working years on his farm on 13 mile creek near Bloomfield. He married Elizabeth Troyer on October 6, 1946, at Mount Pleasant Mennonite Church in Fentress, Virginia. Mahlon loved playing softball and ping pong, and he earned the nickname "Sock" because of how hard he hit the ball. Mahlon was also an avid bowler. His major passion throughout his life was sporting events at all levels. In 1983 Mahlon developed macular degeneration which led to an early retirement. The 16 years he lived at Grandview allowed him many extended walks throughout Glendive, which

he enjoyed.

He is survived by his four sons: Joe (Denise) Borotrager of Glendive, Walter (Linda) Borotrager, Paul (Peggy) Borotrager and Phil Borotrager; ten grandchildren; and thirteen great grandchildren.
