March 19, 1916 - May 30, 2007

Margaret L. Lingk, age 91, of Dickinson, North Dakota, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, died on Thursday, May 24, 2007 at St. Benedict's Nursing Home in Dickinson. A Vigil will be held at 7:00 P.M. Ann's Guild. She was an avid reader and enjoyed doing beautiful embroidery and crocheting. She loved being with her family and will be missed .
