Margaret Louise Malmend, 87, of Glendive, Montana, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, August 17, 2016 at the Glendive Medical Center's Extended Care. At Marge's request no services are planned at this time. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive have been entrusted with the arrangements.

Marge was born on January 16, 1929 to Archie and Francis (Hoffman) Brunelle. Marge was one of seven children born, raised, and educated in Mandan, North Dakota. During the fall of 2010 Marge moved into the Wibaux County Nursing Home where she spent the next five and half years. On August 1, 2016 Marge moved to Glendive Medical Center Extended Care where she resided until her death.

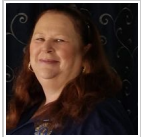
