Margaret Annette Lee was born December 9, 1937 in Lane Montana, the third of four children, to Sanford (Sam) and Violet (Kaiser) Lee. Margaret (everybody called her Margie) grew up on the family farm 12 miles northwest of Richey, Montana, attended elementary and high school in Richey, and graduated with the class of 1955. After graduation, Margaret worked in Wolf Point, Montana as a telephone operator. She met Dale Eggert and they were married on August 19, 1956. To this union, 4 children were born – Debbie, Alex, Tony and Jeff. Dale's occupation as a welder moved them to many different places.

After moving back to Richey in 1967, Margaret was everyone's favorite 'Avon lady', selling door to door. She also worked in the Richey grocery store, bakery and as a Post Office clerk. She retired in 1999 as Postmaster of Richey.

Margaret met George Winhofer through Jaycee's and they were married on December 6, 1972. To this union, Daryn and Kirk were born.

Margaret lived a full life, attending as many events as she could of her children, grandchildren and even great-grandchildren's lives throughout the years. In her mother's later years, Margaret helped take care of her mom, bringing her along to many of the events. Margaret loved to travel! She and George took some of the children and grandchildren on several trips, including Rapid City, Oregon, and even to Canada. Lots of fond memories were made. Margaret was famous for baking the best chocolate chip and molasses

cookies and always had some in the cookie jar or freezer.

She enjoyed wintering in Arizona, playing cards with her friends, and loved to line dance, sometimes being the first one on the dance floor! While in Arizona, she also loved going to the big flea markets and attending Lost Dutchman Days. She was very active! In Margaret's later years, she helped Kirk on the farm by flagging equipment, running for parts and occasionally taking dinners out to him.

Margaret's pride and joy were her family, and was dedicated to her children, grandchildren and many friends. She was loved by all who knew her and will be greatly missed.
