



## Marie Violet Hartl

November 11, 1921 - November 14, 2015

Marie Violet (Weeks) Hartl, age 94, of Fargo, North Dakota, formerly of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Saturday, November 14, 2015 at the Edgewood Vista in Fargo. Funeral Services will be held at 3:00 P.M. on Friday, November 20, 2015 at the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Glendive with Pastor Kevin McDaniel officiating. Marie Violet Weeks was born on November 11, 1921 in Harmar, North Dakota. The family of eleven children moved to the Williston, North Dakota area with their parents. Marie moved to Edgewood Vista in Fargo in April of 2008 where she resided until the time of her death.
