Glendive, Montana: Marie Elizabeth (Nistler) Hollar, age 96, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on Saturday, July 16, 2011 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 20, 2011 at the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 20, 2011 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, July 21, 2011 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach with Reverend Father Russell Kovash officiating. Marie was born on November 2, 1914 in Conway, Arkansas, a daughter of Anton and Mary (Statz) Nistler. At a very early age she moved with her parents and (at the time) six brothers, to Golva, North Dakota where she lived until the age of six. The family moved to Eden Valley, Minnesota where she grew up. Marie did a lot of traveling before she settled in Beach. Marie was married to Francis (Fritz) Hollar on February 4, 1948 in the Assumption Church in Eden Valley. After their marriage they lived on a ranch twenty one miles north of Beach where they farmed and ranched until 1969. After retiring Marie and Fritz moved to Beach where they resided until their passings. Marie was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach, St. Ann's Guild, the Catholic Daughters of America and the Senior Citizens Center. She enjoyed volunteer work, was a sacristan at

church for many years. Marie worked with meals on wheels and was the coordinator and treasurer, she also served on the Golden Valley Council On Aging Board as president and treasurer, and the Henry School District #12, as treasurer, until they moved into Beach. Marie was preceded in death by her husband Fritz on January 27, 1992; her parents; eight brothers, Walt, Aloys (Ole), Frank, Leo, Adolph, Pete Jack, and Werner; one daughter-in-law, Deb Hollar and one grand daughter Donna Hollar. Marie is survived by two sons, Earl Hollar of Dickinson, North Dakota and David (Kathy) Hollar of Beach; two daughters, Helen (Gary) McDanold of Fallon, Montana and Mary (Doug) Ellison of Medora, North Dakota; eight grandchildren and ten great-grand children; one sister Ann Schoolmeesters of Litchfield, Minnesota; one brother, Leonard Nistler of Eden Valley; and one adopted sister, Frances (Bruemer) Tintes of Litchfield; and numerous nephews and nieces.
