Marjie Jordan, 97 of Glendive passed away early in the morning Sunday December 13, 2020 at Glendive Medical Center.

Born to Charles and Cecile (Kielty) Boyle in DeGraff MN on July 27, 1923 she spent her early years in Minnesota which was always home to her. She went out to CA as a young adult to live and work, where she met and married a handsome young sailor Buck Jordan. Four children came along as they lived in California, Minnesota and South Dakota.

At the age of 55 she fulfilled a lifetime dream and enrolled in Alexandria Technical and Community College in MN, earning her LPN Degree. Worried she would not be hired because of her age – she was actually the first one hired from her class! She worked in Minnesota at several hospitals until moving back to California and finally ending up in Glendive. Mom made several trips to Ireland with friends and family, and was so proud of her Irish roots. Mom wasn't ready to retire so volunteering at The Attic was something she thoroughly enjoyed into her 90's.

Preceding her in death were her parents, siblings Bob Boyle, Bill Boyle and Marylou Hertenstein, her husband Buck (2002) and three of her children – Shannon (1971), Pat (2005) and Bill (2019).

She is survived by her sisters Dorothy Totzke, and Bunny (Hal) O'Connor, brother Jerry (Terri) Boyle, daughter Sheila (Rex) Kunick, daughter in law Dar Jordan, grandchildren Amy (Dan Godwin) Steel, Tucker (Amy) Jordan; Sean Jordan; Josh Kunick; Jessica Kunick; Eric (Michelle) Jensen; Nolan (Michelle)
