



## Mark B. Hathaway

February 8, 1954 - April 8, 2006

Mark B. Hathaway, 52, of Stevensville and formerly of Glendive, Montana died Friday, March 31, 2006 at his home. A Vigil Service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Friday, April 7, 2006 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. A Memorial Mass will be held at 10:30 A.M., Saturday, April 8, 2006 in the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Glendive with Fr. Denis Fournier officiating. Mark was born on February 8, 1954 in Glendive, the son of Joseph and Patricia (Rice) Hathaway, the oldest son and second oldest child of seven children. He received his education in Glendive schools, graduating from Dawson County High School with the class of 1972. Following his graduation from high school, Mark entered the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, DC as a fingerprint technician. It was there that he met Mona Lambert and they were married on November 12, 1976. Mark was a successful salesman of furniture, cars and insurance. He returned to college in mid-life and earned a Degree in History from Carroll College in Helena, Montana and then entered law school at the University of Montana in Missoula. Mark graduated from the University of Montana Law School in 1999. He set up a law practice in Glendive and later moved to Missoula. At the time of his death he was practicing law in Stevensville. He loved his Stoney Acres in the Bitterroot Valley but was always very proud of his Eastern Montana roots. Mark was passionate about many things in his life. He was

very proud of his daughters and his granddaughter. He was an avid hunter and was most proud of his trophy big horn sheep. He was a collector of cars, guns, coins and antiques. Survivors include, four daughters, Rachel and Leah Hathaway of Missoula and Noelle and Mariah Hathaway of Bismarck, North Dakota, his parents, Joe and Pat Hathaway of Glendive, two brothers, Peter Hathaway and his wife Marlo of Tucson, Arizona, and Paul Hathaway and his wife Colleen of Madison, Wisconsin; sisters, Patty Pagnotta and her husband Gary of Stevensville, Margaret Bingham and her husband Scott of Phoenix, Arizona, Ann Frazer and her husband Ron of Billings and Teresa Roe and her husband Mike of Glendive; his granddaughter, Sawyer of Missoula and numerous nieces and nephews.
