Marlin Wayne Schipman, age 78, of Glendive, passed away at his home on Saturday, July 17, 2004. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Wednesday, July 21, 2004 at the Westside Baptist Church in Glendive with Pastor Dan Pust officiating. Marlin was born on April 20, 1926 in Boelus, Nebraska, the son of John and Anna (Johnson) Schipman. He was raised and educated in Boelus. Marlin entered the U.S. Army in January of 1945 and served during World War II. Following his honorable discharge in November of 1946, he returned to Nebraska until moving to Whitetail, Montana. Marlin was united in marriage to Lois Cameron on February 12, 1949 in Scobey, Montana. Marlin and his wife lived in the Scobey area until moving to Wolf Point where Marlin was employed by various ranchers as a ranch hand. They then moved to Circle, Montana where Marlin was employed by the McCone County Road Department. They moved to Dawson County in 1958 and moved into Glendive in 1960. Marlin was employed by the Dawson County Road Department as a heavy equipment operator until his retirement in 1988. Marlin enjoyed fishing, gardening and hunting. Marlin was preceded in death by his parents; his grandson, Gage Schipman; one sister, Verda Haake and three brothers, Lyle, Richard and Darrell.
