Glendive, Montana: Mary B. Berry, age 87, of Glendive, Montana passed away on Saturday, April 21, 2012 at St. John's Lutheran Ministries in Billings. Following Marvin's discharge from the United States Army in 1945, they farmed in Fairview and then moved to the family farm in Crane. In 1957, they moved to Glendive and farmed until 1962. Mary greatly enjoyed these years as a homemaker, raising her family on the farm. In the years following, Mary and Marvin owned and operated a restaurant in Glendive until 1991. After the death of her husband in 1994, Mary devoted many hours helping her son Fred with the operation of The Gust Hauf in Glendive. Mary's primary interest was always her family. She loved doing embroidery work and making quilts for them. She also enjoyed cooking and baking with her grandchildren. Some of

her favorite trips included attending A &W Restaurant Conventions throughout the country. She was preceded in death by here parents, Henry and Mary Buxbaum; husband, Marvin in 1994; grandson, Steve Berry in 2000; and three sisters and four brothers.
