Mary A. Starr, age 94, of Glendive, passed away on Tuesday, July 15, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Monday, July 21, 2003 at the United Methodist Church in Glendive with Pastor T.C. Chatman officiating. They farmed near Union and also operated the Starr Coal Mine for several years. Mary was a 4-H leader for the Handy Helper 4-H Club for 35 years and was a past 4-H State Officer. She weighed sugar beets for Holly Sugar for 20 years and later worked at the F & M Dining Club which later became the Montana Inn. Mary was a Red Cross Blood Drive leader. She was active in the Glendive Community Concert Association and the Republican Party. Mary was a member of the United Methodist Church and the Rebekah Circle. Mary was preceded in death by her parents; three brothers, Delbert, Duane and Donald; one sister, Doris England and her grandson, Mark Lunde.
