Mary Sir Veverka, age 94, of Richey, Montana, formerly of Lambert, Montana, died on Sunday, June 29, 2008 at Aspen Meadows in Billings, Montana where she had been a resident since June 2nd. A Memorial Service will be held at 2:00 P.M., Monday, July 7, 2008 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor David Aaseng officiating. Mary worked throughout her life alongside of her husband on the family farm. She always wanted to be a Home Economics teacher so she did the next best thing - she was an active 4-H leader. She was a leader for 25 years - teaching many youth how to sew and cook. She was rewarded by those students coming up to her years later and thanking her for what she had taught them. Mary especially loved her grandchildren and it was important to her that they learn how to cook and sew. When Mary was in her 80's and living in Lambert, she was involved in the 4-H club there so that she could teach her grandsons, Christopher, Jamie and Kurtis, to cook and sew from their grandmother. Mary was especially proud of her grandson, Anton Veverka for the many medals he received in the Special Olympics competitions. Mary always enjoyed visiting with the ranch shepherd,

Victor Vega, a long time employee, who would regularly stop to check on her. Mary was an avid gardener and she enjoyed crocheting, sewing and cooking . She was well known for her "kolace's". She was an active member of the Fox Lake Senior Center in Lambert and attended the First Lutheran Church of Lambert. The friendships that she formed in Lambert were always very special to her. Mary was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; Louis, two brothers, Jerry and Anton Sir and her sister, Lydia Sir.
