MaryRose Peplinski, age 92, of Wibaux, Montana passed away peacefully in her sleep, in the early morning hours of January 5, 2023 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. Visitation will be held from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. with a Vigil Service at 7:00 P.M. on Friday, January 13, 2023 at Silha Funeral Home in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, January 14, 2023 at St. Philip's Catholic Church in St. Philip's, Montana with Father Jose Panickamveli officiating. MaryRose was born on December 8, 1930 in Glen Ullin, North Dakota to Valentine and Margaret (Gartner) Hoffman. She attended grade school in Glendive, Montana and high school in Miles City, Montana. It was here that MaryRose met her high school sweetheart, Paul Peplinski. After high school, MaryRose worked for MDU, until she married Paul in 1952, and they moved to the family farm. Together they raised four children, David, Dan, Karen and Connie.

MaryRose was active in her church as a member of St. Philip's Altar Society, was Sacristan at St. Philip's for many years, was in charge of ministry scheduling and taught CCD. She served as secretary for the Ashline Telephone Company and owned Crossroads Variety for twenty-seven years. MaryRose loved playing cards, bowling, games, gardening and her flowers. She was an excellent cook and made Sunday dinners for her family, which

always included a pie or some dessert. MaryRose loved following her kids, grandkids and great-grandkids sporting events and was known as “Mom”, “Grandma”, “Grandma Pepsi”, and “Grandma Candy”.

MaryRose was preceded in death by her husband, Paul of sixty-two years; her parents, Valentine and Margaret and her three sisters, Pauline, Betty and Katie.
