On April 27, 1945, Mavis married Albert Clarence Moholt when he came home on furlough from the U.S. Army. From this union, they were blessed with three daughters. In 1949, they formed a partnership with Mavis' brother, John, to run the Skogas family farm. In 1968, Clarence and Mavis purchased the farm from Mavis' dad. They lived and farmed there until they sold it in 1984. Mavis was an active member of Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive. In 1999, Clarence and Mavis moved to Billings. Mavis was a devoted, loving wife, mother, grandma, sister and aunt. She brought many happy memories to all of us. Through many years of poor health, her faith and trust in the Lord kept her strong. She will be missed by all of her family, neighbors and friends. She is survived by her husband, Clarence; her

daughters, Vonnie (Darrell) Robson of Billings, Lorna (Duane) Casey of North Richland Hills, Texas, and Vicki (Benny) Finnicum of Butte; her 11 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren; her brother, Art (Joy) Skogas of Libby; sisters-in-law, Helen Skogas of Glendive and Jane Brewster of Ekalaka; and numerous nieces and nephews.
