Maxine (Chapman) Svenvold, age 92, of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Friday, December 13, 2013 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in Glendive. Svenvold. they were later married in Miles City, Montana in 1943. After their marriage she stayed busy helping on the farm, raising their children and substitute teaching when needed. After Ronald's death in 1979, Maxine remained on the farm until the mid eighties when she moved to Glendive. She enjoyed quilting, gardening, time spent with her friends in the Ladies Birthday Club, traveling and attending the cousins reunion joined by her family each year. She loved

spending time with her family especially her grandchildren. Maxine was a volunteer at the Attic in Glendive. She was a member of the Deer Creek Lutheran Church; where she taught Sunday School, Zion Lutheran Church, and Zion Quilters. She was always involved in the Deer Creek Bazaar.
