



## Mildred "Millie" Hamilton

February 11, 1918 - August 18, 2006

Mildred Florence Hamilton, age 88, of Beach, North Dakota, passed away on August 14, 2006, at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana.
