September 29, 1930 - July 17, 2023

Mildred Ruth (Hostetler) Johnson of Glendive, MT passed into the arms of Jesus on July 17th, 2023 at the wonderful age of 92. Mildred was born on September 29th of 1930 to Edward and Violet Hostetler in Bloomfield, MT. In 1947, Mildred met her husband, Elmer Johnson. One year later on a Sunday evening, their pastor announced: "We have a couple getting married this evening and everyone is invited to stay". Mildred and Elmer went on to have 7 children: Roy (Sheryl) of Glendive, Merv (Barb) of Bloomfield, Sue (Dave) of Billings, Betty (Marty) of Richey, Bob (LaVonne) of Illinois, Marie (Clinton) of North Carolina, George (Bernie) of Glendive.

Mildred spent much of her time sewing, quilting, and embroidering for her family up until the age of 87. While living on the farm, she would have much rather been working alongside her husband than doing housework or cooking. Her children have fond memories of ice skating and roller skating with their parents. Whenever there was a storm, Mildred would read her children an entire book by Danny Orlis.

Mildred is preceded in death by her mother, father, husband, two brothers (Robert and George), grandson (Colby), and two great grandchildren (Paige and Jasper). She is survived by her 7 children, 19 grandchildren, 60 great grandchildren, and 4 great great grandchildren. Her service will be held at Red Top Church on Monday, July 24th at 11:00am with a luncheon to follow. The burial of the ashes will follow the luncheon for those wishing to attend.
