Mildred A. Pedersen, age 94, of Glendive, passed away on Thursday, February 7, 2008 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. Memorial services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, February 12, 2008 at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. They lived in Wibaux until 1942 when they moved to Glendive. Mildred had worked at the Northern Pacific Hospital for 24 years as a nurses aide. She was a charter member of the Cottonwood Homemakers Club, located north of Wibaux. Mildred enjoyed sewing, embroidery, hunting, fishing and crossword puzzles. She also enjoyed raising plants, gardening and had won several prizes for her potatoes when she was in high school.
