



Mildred "Mickey" Evelyn Sampson

December 5, 1915 - August 21, 2015

Mildred "Mickey" Evelyn Sampson, age 99, of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Friday, August 21, 2015 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Visitation will be held from 6:00 P.M. until 7:00 P.M. on Sunday, August 23, 2015 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Funeral Services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Monday, August 24, 2015 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Greg Lucido officiating. Interment will be held in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Mickey was born on December 5, 1915 in Polson, Montana to Alfred and Susanna (Gausted) Berg. After her father passed away, the family moved to Absarokee, Montana to be closer to her mother's family. Mickey was raised and educated in Absarokee, graduating with honors from Absarokee High School in 1935. Following high school, Mickey moved to Glendive to find work where she quickly met and married Vurr Cady on November 13, 1935 in Wibaux, Montana and to this union two daughters were born. Vurr passed away suddenly in 1970. Mickey later met and married Lyle Sampson on August 3, 1974 in Glendive, they were married for only a few years when Lyle passed away from cancer. Mickey remained in Glendive until her passing. Mickey enjoyed fishing, crafts and quilting at Our Savior Lutheran Church. She loved to cook and was very well known for her twenty plus years of cooking at George's Sandwich shop. Her specialty was the hot beef and hot pork sandwiches because of her secret gravy recipe. Mickey cherished the

time she was able to spend with her family and all of the kids in her neighborhood. She was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church and the Glendive Hospital Auxiliary.

She was preceded in death by her parents; two husbands, Vurr Cady and Lyle Sampson; three brothers, Art, Alvin and Herb Berg and one son-in-law, Ed Kalloch.

Survivors include her two daughters, Pat Kalloch of Glendive, Shirley (Lloyd) Aspenlieder of Culbertson, Montana, one step son Melvin (Kathy) Sampson of Bismarck, North Dakota; four grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
