February 20, 1917 - December 29, 2005

Myrtle Allen, age 88 of Dickinson, North Dakota, formerly of Beach, North Dakota, died in Dickinson on December 25, 2005. A Vigil service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Wednesday, December 28, 2005 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Beach. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 2:00 P.M., Thursday, December 29, 2005 at St. John The Baptist Catholic Church in Beach with Rev. Fr. David Richter officiating. Rite of Committal will be in St. John's Cemetery in Beach with Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Beach entrusted with arrangements.
