Nell M. Perrett, age 95 of Wibaux, Montana, died on Thursday February 5, 2015 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux. Silha Funeral Home of Wibaux is entrusted with arrangements. Services are pending. Nell May Perrett age 95, of Wibaux, Montana, was born in Gordon, Nebraska, to Peter and Blanche Andersen, Nell grew up with 8 siblings. She became a school teacher and met a pupil's older brother, Royce Perrett, who she wed in 1944. After WWII, Royce and Nell began ranching which took them from the Sand hills of Nebraska, Isabel, South Dakota and to Wibaux, Montana, for the next 70 years.

Nell developed polio in 1950 and though it made many changes in her life, it only slowed her down a bit. Royce and Nell had three children who continued to be an important part of their lives.

Nell was a 50-year member of the Order of Eastern Star and Daughters of the Nile, a talented seamstress, and always a teacher. For many years, she was a 4-H leader, mentoring youth in the Isabel community. She became an acclaimed quilter and enjoyed collecting (especially thimbles), following bull riding, and watching her family grow. She so loved her children, their spouses, grandchildren, great grandchildren, and Royce.

She is survived by her husband Royce, brother Joe, children Marc (Laurie), Barb Lutz (Arny), Jerry (Rayetta), grandchildren Megan Huber (Andy), Courtney Pushcar (Shaun), and great grandchildren Hadley, Jonell and Hunter.
