Nellie J. Booth, 83, of Wibaux, Montana passed away peacefully Wednesday, December 1, 2021 at St. Luke's Nursing Home in Dickinson, North Dakota. Visitation will be held from 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. with a Prayer Service at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, December 10, 2021 at Silha Funeral Home in Beach, North Dakota. A Funeral Service will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, December 11, 2021 at the United Community Church with Pastor Warren Maxted officiating. Nellie worked for Rice Oil (Skelly's, Flying J), and later co-owned Beach Freight Service. Nellie and family moved out to the Booth Family Farm in 1983, where they raised their family, and farmed for many years. In 1992, Nellie and DuWayne moved to Mesa, Arizona operating the Western Acres Mobile Home Park. In June 2000, Nellie and DuWayne moved back to the farm in Wibaux. In 2015, Nellie moved to the Golden Valley Manor in Beach where she resided until June 2021, then moving to St. Luke's Nursing Home in Dickinson.

Nellie enjoyed knitting, crocheting, sewing, canning, and making jelly. Nellie could always be counted to be a partner in a pinochle game. She also enjoyed whist, canasta, and uno. Nellie always had a puzzle book in her pocket. If you needed a greeting card, she was sure to have one for any occasion.

Nellie is preceded in death by her grandparents, parents, and her husband DuWayne.
