



Neva Wyman

January 1, 1753 - November 1, 2005

Neva Garnet Wyman, 95, of Glendive, passed away Tuesday, October 25, 2005, at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, November 1, 2005 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson County Cemetery. A luncheon at the Silvernale-Silha Tribute Center will follow the committal service. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. On November 5, 1909, Neva was born to homesteader parents, George William and Ella May (Irvin) Adkins at Flat Creek Township near White Butte, South Dakota. Her three older siblings had been born in the sod house, but she was the first child born in the frame home. She attended Adkins School in Perkins County, loved helping her dad outside, and grew to be a caring hard working woman in a close family of eight. Neva and Weston F. Wyman were married at Lemmon, South Dakota on December 12, 1931. With two young sons, Neva and Wes and several Adkins families moved out to the Yakima Valley in the state of Washington. Two more sons joined the family and Neva busied herself with home making. She worked at a turkey processing plant, sorted potatoes, and other odd jobs while living on the May Place near Moses Lake, Washington. The family moved back to South Dakota to farm near Athboy. Winters were harsh and in the early 50's Glendive became their home. Neva was employed by Star Hi Hatcheries, and later F. W. Woolworth as a salesclerk for many years. After her retirement from

Woolworths, she taught herself to crochet with yarn and set out to make all of her grandchildren and great grandchildren afghans. She was a Rebecca Lodge member, enjoyed people, was a proficient seamstress, and cook, who loved baking breads and cookies. She had a sharp sense of humor that was unmatched, and was forever teasing with fun. She loved plants, and at one time had over 100 African violets. Dogs and children loved her, and she always had pet cats. Collecting china teapots and fancy dishes was a hobby which she proudly displayed. Neva had been a resident of Carolyn's Care Center for several years before moving to Glendive Medical Center in 2004. Neva is survived by two sons, Lewis Wyman and his wife Joy of Ephrata, Washington; Ellis Wyman and his wife Rose of Glendive; 11 grandchildren, 16 great grandchildren, and one great great granddaughter. Two loving daughters-in-law, Dorothy Roberts of Parker, Arizona, and Diane Wyman of Peoria, Arizona; two sisters, Belle Krueger of Yakima, and Gladys (Clyde) Woods of Selah, Washington and numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband Weston in 1982; her sons, Page Weston in 1959, and Neil Gary in 2003; twin grandchildren and three great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by four brothers Kyle, Roy, Everett and Kenneth Adkins, and one sister, Clara Stitt.
