Nicolene Roald Rockstead, a long-time resident of Maui and Oahu, formerly of Glendive, passed away on October 4, 2005 in Vancouver, Washington, where she had resided the past two years in order to be close to her son. Graveside services will be held at 10:30 A.M., Monday, May 22, 2006 at the Dawson memorial Cemetery in Glendive with Father Benjamin Lobo officiating.

Nicolene was born in Weldon, Montana, the second child of a family of seven of Olaf and Elizabeth Roald, on April 4, 1917. The family moved to Glendive when their mother became ill and passed away. The children attended a country school until their father moved to town and Nicolene graduated from Dawson County High School. She married C. Jay Rockstead on October 17, 1938, they lived in Glens Fall, New York, for several years, then moved their family of three children to Hawaii until Jay passed away in 1998. Nicolene was an active volunteer throughout her lifetime, in particular for the Episcopal Churches she attended as well as the Honolulu Symphony, the Miss Teenage America and Miss Hawaii competitions on Maui. After a successful career in fashion modeling, she founded and operated the Maui School of Charm and Modeling. She is survived by her son, Jay Rockstead, Vancouver, Washington, daughters, Tanya (Gap) Bova, Goodyear, Arizona, and Sonja Hayslip of Honolulu, three grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. She is also survived by her two sisters, Frances (Joe) Pisk, Glendive and Ethel (Kale) Rogers, of Billings, sister-in-law, Mary Lou Roald, Gresham, Oregon,

and brother-in-law, Richard Anesi, Billings. Nicolene was preceded in death by her parents, sisters Thelma Anesi and Maxine McCall, and two brothers, Norman and Spencer.
