Glendive, Montana: Norma Agnas (Dahl) Heafield, age, 91, died on Sunday, April 7, 2013 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care in Glendive. Funeral Services will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, April 13, 2013 at the First Congregational United Church of Christ with Brother Guy Pontoriero officiating. Norma was born on September 13, 1921 in Columbus, North Dakota, the daughter of Gustav and Marie (Martinsen) Dahl. Norma worked in an Aircraft Factory during World War II in California where she met her future husband, Gordon Heafield. Norma and Gordon were united in marriage on December 3, 1943 and to this union three children were born. Following Gordon's medical discharge from military service, Norma and he moved to Appam, North Dakota until they moved to Lindsay, Montana where they raised their family together. Norma was the bookkeeper for the Farmer's Union Elevator in Lindsay and Glendive Livestock and Sales Ring in Glendive. She then worked at the Post Office in Lindsay, where she was the Postmaster for nearly thirty years before she retired. Norma was a member of the Clear Creak Homemakers Club, Toastmasters Club in Glendive, Priscilla Circle of

Congregational Church in Glendive, President of Montana Postal Association, and Supervisory Committee of the Badlands Credit Union. She enjoyed traveling and spending time with her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren and her many dear friends. She was preceded in death by her parents, Gustav and Marie Dahl; husband of fifty-four years, Gordon Heafield in 1997; one infant son, Gordon Jr.; one sister and four brothers. Survivors include her children, Harold (Renasu) Heafield of Glendive and Susan (Brian Wren) Heafield of Sidney, New York; three grandchildren, Scott Heafield (Sandra Miller) of La Salle, Colorado, Sonya (Gary) Harnish of Sheridan, Wyoming and Nathan (Heather) Heafield of Bartonsville, Pennsylvania; three great-grandchildren, Colin, Liam and Norah and numerous nieces and nephews.
