Pacer Fallon Holley, age 43 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 at the Glendive Medical Center after a short battle with cancer. Cremation has taken place and no local services are planned at this time. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Pacer was born on October 8, 1977 in Sonora, Texas to his parents Mike and Marsha (Daniel) Holley. He was raised and educated in Sonora, graduating from Sonora High School with the class of 1996.
