Patty Lou “Pat” Robinson, of Wibaux, Montana passed away peacefully on January 25, 2024 in Butte, Montana.

Pat was born on March 22, 1934 to Pete and Marvel (Carlson) Tometich in Slater, Iowa. The family moved to Charles City, IA where she attended school, graduating in 1951. Following graduation, Pat moved to Washington DC, and went to work as a secretary for the FBI.

It was while working and living in DC that Pat met Marvin Robinson, who was in the U.S. Air Force and stationed there. Marv and Pat married in December of 1951, and to this union four children were born. The couple moved to Montana, residing in Glendive and Opheim, finally settling in Wibaux in 1963. Pat started working for Action for Eastern Montana in 1968, where she was instrumental in establishing the Wibaux Senior Citizens Center. Pat enjoyed working with those in need, especially the elderly. In 1982, Pat went to work for attorney R.W. Heineman, until she retired at the age of eighty-two.

Pat enjoyed spending time with family and friends near and far. She thought the world of her dog, Belle, and babied her tremendously. This included sharing her pancakes and hamburgers with her. Once Belle crossed the Rainbow Bridge, Pat felt lost without her.

One of Pat’s favorite hobbies was playing cards. No matter who was around, a deck of cards was usually brought out for a game of gin rummy or pinochle. She was a member of a Bridge Club and Pinochle Club for years. More recently, Pat enjoyed playing Crazy Eights with her great-granddaughters. She

also enjoyed playing Bingo, knitting, reading and watching her favorite sports teams. Pat also loved horse racing during the years she and Marv owned racehorses.

Pat is survived by her three daughters, LeAnne (Jim) Sarver of UT, Lori Robinson of MT, and Julie Robinson of UT; stepson, John (CJ) Lucero of NM; daughter-in-law, Mary Robinson of MT; brother-in-law, Bob (Mary) Fossum of MT; sisters-in-law, Roxie Tometich of NM, Virginia Serwold of WA, Ruth Robson of MT, Carole (Mike) Zeitner of WA, Janet Fossum of MT, Sarah (Chuck) Thompson of FL and Rose Fossum of AZ; ten grandchildren; fourteen great-grandchildren along with numerous nephews, nieces, cousins and her many friends. 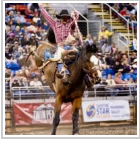
