Glendive, Montana: Patricia Ann Bell, age 80, died on Saturday, April 2, 2011, at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Pat was born on December 11, 1930, in Sherwood, North Dakota, the daughter of Clarence Martin and Mabel Florence (Gumphrey) Brown. Pat's family moved to Glendive when she was a young girl. She was raised and educated in Glendive, graduating from Dawson County High School with the class of 1948. After high school, Pat attended dental assistant school in San Francisco, California. After graduation, she returned to Glendive and worked for Dr. Hurning. Pat married George Langdon Bell on November 10, 1950, in Glendive. They had three children. Pat worked at Fashion Island as a window dresser and buyer until she and Langdon purchased the Glendive Transfer and Storage Co. She and Langdon ran that business together until 1986, when they sold it and retired. Pat was an active member of Zion Lutheran Church, a member of the women's group, chancel guild, and memorial committee, as well as serving as parish treasurer. She also enjoyed civic activities, such as Beta Sigma Phi and the PEO, where she served as

president. Over the years, she and Langdon liked to escape to Fort Peck Lake on weekends in the summer and play cards with the "Whist Club." In retirement, she enjoyed traveling, attending elder hostels and sewing. She spent many pleasant hours reading and loved being with her family, especially her grandsons. Pat was preceded in death by her parents; her daughter, MaryAnn Maciag; and her sister, June B. May. Survivors include her husband, Langdon Bell of Glendive; daughter, Holli (Matthew) Christensen of Yakima, Washington; son, Thomas (Holly) Bell of Johnstown, New York; brother, Eugene Brown of Saratoga, California; and grandsons, David Maciag of Wesley Chapel, Florida, Christopher Bell of Johnstown, New York and Kjell Christensen of Yakima, Washington.
