Patrick William Bohn, age 85, of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota, passed away on Thursday, November 23, 2023 at St. Benedict's Health Care in Dickinson, ND. Visitation will be from 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. with a Vigil Service held at 7:00 P.M. on Thursday, November 30, 2023 at St. John's Catholic Church in Beach, North Dakota. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Friday, December 1, 2023 at St. John's Catholic Church with Father Nicholas Vetter officiating. Rite of Committal will be at St. Michael's Cemetery in Sentinel Butte. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Patrick "Pat" William Bohn was born on March 17, 1938 in Dickinson to Charles Sr.

and Katherine "Olive" (Lardy) Bohn. Pat grew up in Sentinel Butte on the family farm just

south of town, graduating from Sentinel Butte High School in 1957.

Pat served in the U.S. Army from 1961-1963. He was stationed in Germany; receiving training as a sharpshooter and working in the general warehouse.

Upon returning stateside and honorably discharged, he went back to work on the family farm. Pat also worked as a ranch/farm hand for several farmers and ranchers around the area and at West Plain Implement prior to starting work for the North Dakota Department of Transportation. He first worked as a caretaker of the Sentinel Butte rest areas and then moved to the road maintenance division where he stayed until his retirement.

Pat married Eleanor Dietz on November 26, 1966. They had five children: Sherri, Renae, Nichole, Troy, and Kelly. He taught his children a love for DIY, gardening, and caring for animals. Pat enjoyed helping his children with their 4-H projects by getting the cattle ready for showing, growing many vegetables, and helping with woodworking projects.

During his retirement, he put his mechanical skills to use by refurbishing lawnmowers from old parts. Pat was a volunteer firefighter for many years and received a Lifetime Firefighters Award in 1996. He also volunteered his time by taking on various roles for St.

Michael's and St. Mary's Catholic Churches.

Pat is survived by his five children, Sherri (Joel) Walker, Renae Hegge, Nichole (Maurus) Bohn, Troy Bohn, and Kelly (Steven) Wetzstein; eleven grandchildren, Jacob (Molly) Walker, Jamie (Ben) Johnson, Jodi Walker, Tyrel (Regina) Bohn, Mika Hegge, Meghan

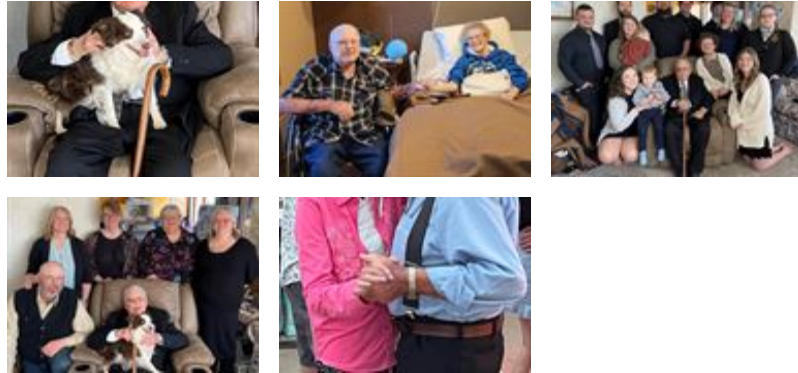

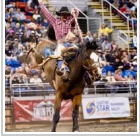
