Patrick D. Denning, age 53, of Minot, North Dakota, formerly of Glendive, Montana, passed away on Saturday, October 28, 2006 in Bismarck, North Dakota. Memorial services with military honors will be held at 10:00 A.M., Saturday, November 4, 2006 in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor Larry Phalen officiating. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Pat was born on June 11, 1953 in Hays, Kansas, the son of Ralph and Mary (Obley) Denning. His family moved to Glendive where he was raised and educated and ultimately graduated from Dawson County High School with the class of 1971. Pat worked on the oil rigs and at Acme Tool. He then began his career in law enforcement when he went to work for the Glendive Police Department and later for the Dawson County Sheriff's Department where he served as a deputy undersheriff and eventually sheriff. Pat was the first warden at the Dawson County Corrections Facility, a position he held until moving to Phoenix, Arizona. In 2002 he moved to Minot where he was employed by True Value and was working there at the time of his death. Pat enjoyed hunting and fishing and spending time with his family. He was a member of the Montana Army National Guard from 1971 until he retired in 1986. Survivors include his daughters, Heather Denning of Minot, North Dakota and Shauna Denning of Glendive; two sons, Shawn Denning of Plentywood, Montana and Andrew Denning of Glendive; three brothers, Mike Denning of Chandler, Arizona, Curt Denning of Auburn, Washington and Brad Denning of Bellingham,

Washington; one grandchild due to be born in January 2007.
