



Paul Douglas Anderson

July 2, 1935 - July 29, 2015

A memorial service with military honors for Paul Douglas Anderson, age 80, of Glendive, Montana will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Tuesday, August 4, 2015 at Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson and Pastor Stan Hoobing officiating. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Paul “Doug” Anderson was born July 2, 1935 in Fargo, North Dakota, and became the center of the universe to Freeman and Blanch Anderson of Valley City, North Dakota. He graduated from Valley City High School in 1953 and went on to serve his country overseas until 1956 where he received a Good Conduct Medal. He returned to his beloved community to graduate from Valley City State College in 1959.

In 1959, he found the two loves of his life in Glendive, Montana, teaching and his wife, Sandra Vinje. They were married for 55 years at the time of his death. They were the definition of commitment and enduring love and Doug always had a smile when Sandy’s name was brought up.

It was with great passion and enthusiasm he taught at Dawson County High School. “P A”, as some of his favorite students fondly called him, was larger than life. He remembered every student he taught, accepted them as who they were, saw potential in each one, and gave them not so subtle nudges to do their best in life. He was proud of his students and followed their successes through-out the years.

Family had deep meaning to Doug as he was blessed with a community and

close friends that were considered family. He found great joy in fishing, hunting, and partaking in just about anything that meant friends were gathered in good spirits. Doug's summer work as an insurance adjuster allowed him to extend his circle of friends across the country.

Doug and Sandra were blessed with two children, Karen and Steve. Doug passed his love of life and passions for fishing and hunting to both his children and his grandchildren. Many memories centered around the great outdoors and he looked forward to every trip with his grandchildren and friends. Doug was a very big part of everyone's life due to his continued involvement and unwavering dedication to his extended family. He could be heard at various sporting events shouting encouragement and took great joy in watching his grandchildren participate in all their activities.

Doug just celebrated his 80th birthday and was so tickled with the mountain of cards, phone calls and visitors that made it a truly special day. He suffered a stroke and passed away July 29, 2015. Doug's passing leaves us missing his spunk, laughter, and strength. He was our anchor and rock. We know he is with his daughter Karen, who preceded him to heaven, and is in a better place. He can watch over us all with a cigar in one hand and a drink in the other and we will continue to hear the voice of encouragement as we always have.

Doug leaves behind his loving wife, Sandra Anderson of Billings; son, Steven (Laurie) Anderson of Laurel, Montana; son-in-law, Brett Price of Arlington, Washington; grandsons, Jake and Josh of Laurel, and Derek Dizney of Salem, Oregon; and great-grandson Wyatt of Salem.

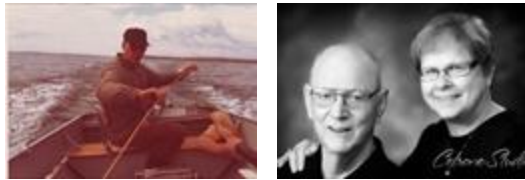

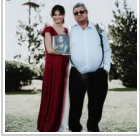
