January 9, 1944 - February 26, 2011

Glendive, Montana: Paul Douglas Gebow, age 67, passed away Saturday, February 26, 2011 at his home in Glendive. No services are planned at this time. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements. Paul was born on January 9, 1944 in Stoneham, Massachusetts, the son of Arthur and Dorothy (Vaughn) Gebow. Paul was drafted into the United States Army in August 1964. He spent six months in Vietnam, and was wounded three times. Paul graduated from Atlantic Union College in 1970 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Behavioral Sciences. In 1979 he received a Masters of Art Degree in Counseling from Framingham State College. Paul married Janice Timm in October of 1971, they spent the last ten years in Glendive. Paul worked in several professions during his civilian career; Retail Management, counseling adults and youth, YMCA Director, and working with youth in various settings. Paul also spent thirty years working with one of the United States Governments Agencies in contract work, earning a Masters of Science in Behavioral Science and an Education Degree in Systematic Techniques of Counseling, through Federal sponsored schools. Paul retired in 2000 due to health problems and he and Janice were planning to stay in Glendive for the remainder of their time. They lived west of town and enjoyed staying at home, gardening, reading and camping. He was preceded in death by his parents, and one sister, Charlene. Paul is survived by his wife Janice, of Glendive; a sister in Wakefield, Massachusetts; and a brother in Arizona. Remembrances and condolences
