Glendive, Montana: Paul "Bulldog" Michael Geiger, age 19, passed away on March 28, 2012 due to a tragic car accident outside of Glendive. He wrestled until he was sixteen and during that time he competed at the Grand National level on two different occasions. He was an avid skier since he was just one years old, enjoyed fishing, hunting and had a love for baseball; having played Little League through Babe Ruth. Paul played on a team that won the local

championship two consecutive years. Motorcycles and going fast were another activity Paul favored. Paul was preceded in death by his mother, Teresa Minarik in 2001 and paternal grandparents, Michael and Dorothy Geiger.
