



## Paul D Peplinski

Paul D. Peplinski, age 81, of Wibaux, Montana, passed away on Sunday, June 29, 2014 at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dickinson, North Dakota. Farmers Union board of Beach, the Ashline Telephone board, the MonDak Wool Growers and the St. Philip's School Board. He could fix and repair about anything, he was a mechanic and loved swathing and combining. Last year, Paul even ran the combine all through the harvest season.

Paul was preceded in death by his parents; brother, Stanley Peplinski; infant sister, Helen Peplinski and sister, Leona Peplinski.
