Paul Bradley Ward, our beloved Brad, passed away at his home on Sunday, May 16, 2021 in Glendive, Montana. 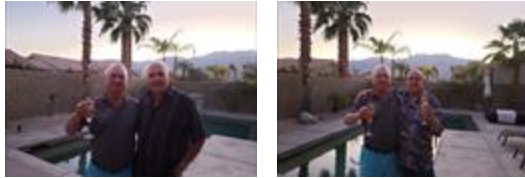

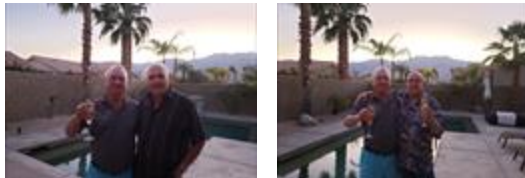
