Pauline "Polly" Rosh Knaus Foos, age 96, of Glendive, passed away on Sunday, December 9, 2007 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. She will be remembered for her deep faith in God, her sense of humor, and always asking guests, "How do I look"? Funeral services will be held at 1:00 P.M., Friday, December 14, 2007 at the Zion Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor Avis Anderson officiating. Polly was born on July 23, 1911 in Windsor, Colorado, the daughter of Henrich and Marie Elizabeth (Kerbs) Rosh. She was raised and educated in Windsor. In 1931, Polly was united in marriage to Carl Fred Knaus in Windsor. To this union, three daughters were born, Shirley Ruth, Doris Ann and Carol Eileen. Polly and Carl tragically lost their daughter, Shirley Ruth "Ruthie", at the young age of 3 ½. Polly and her family moved to the Bridger, Montana area in 1942 where they raised their daughters on a farm. In 1949, they relocated to Billings, Montana. Polly moved to Glendive in 1958 to join her daughter, Doris and her family. During this time, Polly frequently babysat for many Glendive families, particularly those with large families. Carl preceded Polly in death in 1973. Polly began work as a nurses' aide at the Northern Pacific Hospital until her marriage to George Foos in 1974. Polly and George lived in Billings until 1990 when Polly returned to Glendive to be near her daughter, Carol. Polly was an excellent seamstress and was the apple of her father's eye. She inherited her father's perfectionism.

Polly was an Atlanta Braves fan and passed on to her daughters great German recipes. Every new family member is introduced to butterball soup on Christmas Eve. Pauline was preceded in death by her parents; husbands, Carl in 1973 and George in 1998; her siblings, Henry, Fred, David, John, George, Adam, Katie, Eva, Molly and Marie.
