



## Pauline J. Minks

September 13, 1925 - March 3, 2005

Pauline J. Minks, age 79, of Sentinel Butte, North Dakota, died on Friday, February 25, 2005 at the Wibaux County Nursing Home in Wibaux, Montana. Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 A.M., Thursday, March 3, 2005 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Beach with Rev. Scott Hojnacki officiating. Interment will follow at the Beach City Cemetery. Her parents died at a early age and she was raised and educated in an orphanage in Montreal. As a young woman Pauline moved to Billings, Montana where she cooked in a restaurant. In 1951 she met Harvey Minks at the restaurant. They were married on September 15, 1953 in Spokane, Washington. After their marriage they moved to Marsh, Montana where Harvey worked for the railroad. In December of 1953 they moved to Sentinel Butte, North Dakota where they lived until 1955 when they moved back to Marsh, Montana. In December of 1958 they moved to Golva, North Dakota where they lived until 1961. In June of 1961 they bought a home in Sentinel Butte where they presently reside. Pauline was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Beach, North Dakota. She loved to trim trees and shrubs, gardening and playing Bridge with her friends. Pauline loved to cook and was excellent at it. She cooked at several places in the Beach and Medora area including the Chuck Wagon in Medora, the Truck Stop in Beach and the School in Sentinel Butte as well as several other places in the area. Pauline was preceded in death by a daughter Sandra Creamer.

Pauline is survived by her husband, Harvey of the family home in Sentinel Butte: one son, David Minks of Grand Forks, North Dakota along with two grandsons and one granddaughter.
