March 6, 1909 - December 20, 2003

Pearl Opal (Harman) Konig, age 94, of Glendive, passed away on Monday, December 8, 2003 at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive. Memorial services will be held at 10:00 A.M., Saturday, December 20, 2003 at the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Glendive with Pastor T.C. Chatman officiating. Interment will be in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Pearl was born on March 6, 1909 in Rockport, Missouri, a daughter of Eunice (O'Gillilan) and John Buckmiller. The family moved to Wyoming by covered wagon when she was a small child. Her early education was in Gillette, Wyoming where she completed elementary school in 1924 and Campbell County High School in 1927. She earned an Associate Degree in Elementary Education at Eastern Montana College in 1961 and a B.S. degree in 1966. In 1933, she married Charles G. Harman in Columbus, Montana. She later married John Konig in Miles City in 1949 and again in Las Vegas in 1977. During World War II, Pearl worked at the Great Western Sugar Factory in Billings and contributed to the war effort by welding and riveting Army tank retriever turrets. Her professional career was devoted to teaching elementary education in rural schools in Yellowstone, Prairie, Rosebud and Dawson counties. Pearl joined the First Methodist Church in Glendive in 1955 and has been associated with it ever since. She also had an enduring interest in raising and riding horses. Other hobbies included fishing, agate hunting, sewing, gardening and reading. Pearl was preceded in death by three sisters,

Edith, Mary, and Elsie. Survivors include her son, Charles J. (Jacqueline) Harman of Billings; grandchildren, Michelle and Gregory Harman of Boston, and various nieces and nephews.
